Winemaking: Fermented in neutral Bourgogne oak barrels and aged "Sur Lie" for eight months. Almost all of the processes done in the winery are gravitational and therefore do not harm the wine's unique aroma. Lewinsohn Blancs do not go through Malolactic fermentation in order to maintain their high, natural acidity and elegance.

Tasting Notes: Elegant, Côte de Beaune Styled Chardonnay with grapefruit, lime, guava, sea breeze and minerals. A high and well-balanced acidity on the palate with a very long finish of lime and white flowers. This wine will age well for a decade
