Varietals: Syrah 50%, Petite Syrah 25%, Carignan 25%

Alcohol: 14%

Terrior: Upper Galilee, Terra Rossa. Jerusalem Hills, Ancient limestone and clay.

Winemaking: Fermented in small, open top tanks, with frequent punch down. Skin contact is limited to the duration of fermentation extracting the purest expression of the carefully chosen fruit.

The wine was aged in Burgundy French oak barrels for 15 months.

Almost all of the processes done in the winery are gravitational and therefore do not harm the wine's unique aroma.

Tasting Notes: Prunes and small berries, Black pepper, earthy notes, Licorice, Lavender and Mediterranean herbs. This full-bodied wine has an extraordinary acidity and structure, and a long and sensual floral finish.

This wine will age well for a decade and beyond.
