Varietal: Chardonnay

Alcohol: 12.5%

Terrior: Upper Galilee, limestone and Terra Rossa soil.

Winemaking: Fermented in neutral Burgundy oak barrels and aged sur lie for eight months. Nearly all of the stages of transferring the wine are done through a gravitational process, which prevents any of the delicate aromas from being lost. Lewinsohn's white wines do not undergo malolactic fermentation in order to maintain their naturally high acidity and balance.

Tasting Notes: An elegant, Côte de Beaune style Chardonnay, its nose exhibits peach, citrus, minerals and a luxurious sea breeze, Almonds and hazelnuts.

The palate follows through with well-balanced acidity and a generously long finish showing off lime and white flowers.

This wine is approachable and enjoyable now, and will age well for a decade.


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
