Varietal: Chardonnay

Alcohol: 13%

Terrior: Upper Galilee, limestone and Terra Rossa soil.

Winemaking: Fermented in neutral Burgundy oak barrels and aged sur lie for eight months. Nearly all of the stages of transferring the wine are done through a gravitational process, which prevents the delicate aromas from being lost. Lewinsohn's white wines do not undergo malolactic fermentation in order to maintain their naturally high acidity and balance.

Tasting Notes: An elegant, Côte de Beaune style Chardonnay, its nose exhibits peach, tropical fruits, minerals and a luxurious sea breeze, Almonds and hazelnuts.

The palate follows through with well-balanced acidity and a generously long finish showing off lime and white flowers.

This wine is approachable and enjoyable now, and will age well for a decade.
